BLANKET STANDING ORDER
SUBSTITUTING THE SAN MATEO
COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CHILD
SUPPORT SERVICES IN ALL SUPPORT
CASES ENFORCED BY THE DISTRICT
ATTORNEY OF SAN MATEO COUNTY

TO: ALL PARTIES IN CASES INVOLVING PATERNITY AND SUPPORT ISSUES
ENFORCED BY THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO:

Upon application of the District Attorney of the County of San
Mateo pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 284, subparagraph 2,
and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED THAT the San Mateo County Department of Child
Support Services is hereby substituted for the District Attorney of
San Mateo County as the local child support agency representing the
public interest in establishing, modifying, and enforcing support
obligations as provided in Family Code section 17406.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

Henceforth, all papers and documents in actions or proceedings
involving the establishment of paternity or the establishment,


1 modification or enforcement of support in which the District Attorney
2 has appeared pursuant to Family Code section 17400 et seq. or
3 otherwise, shall be served on the San Mateo San Mateo County
4 Department of Child Support Services as follows:

8 All papers and documents served upon the District Attorney at the
9 above address, in actions or proceedings involving the establishment
10 of paternity or the establishment, modification or enforcement of
11 support shall be deemed served upon the San Mateo County Department
12 of Child Support Services, which office shall perform the support
13 establishment and enforcement functions formerly performed by the
14 District Attorney.

15 Notice of this order shall be given to the public by posting a
16 copy of same in the courthouse in a place reserved for public notices
17 for a period of not less than ninety (90) days, and by publication of
18 a copy of this order in a newspaper of general circulation published
19 in this County that is most likely to give notice to litigants in the
20 above-described proceedings.
