This Court finds that the Victim Center of San Mateo County is a division of the San Mateo County District Attorney's Office and a properly designated local Victim Center pursuant to Government Code Section 13951 (h) and Penal Code Section 13835.2.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that notwithstanding Welfare and Institutions Code 827, the Victim Center of San Mateo County may request and law enforcement agencies and Children and Family Services shall release reports of law enforcement agencies (involving juvenile victims and/or suspects) and upon request, a copy of a petition filed in a Juvenile Court proceeding, reports of the probation officer, any other document made available to the probation officer or to the judge, referee, or other hearing officer, a complete copy of the report regarding the incident, and any supplemental reports involving the crime, as set forth in Government Code Section 13954 (d) for the purpose of assisting victims of violent crime pursuant to Government Code Section 13950 et seq. and

Penal Code Section 13835 et seq.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all law enforcement agencies and Children and Family

Services shall release said juvenile records to the Victim Center of San Mateo County upon receipt of
this Standing Order of the Juvenile Court.
