IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is the agency designated to serve as Probate Conservator of the Person and Estate of those individuals who are unable to meet their basic needs for physical health, food, clothing, or shelter, and/or who are unable to manage his/her own financial resources or resist fraud or undue influence when no other person is appointed to serve in that capacity. The Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is appointed as Conservator of the Person and Estate in LPS Conservatorship proceedings when the individual under the disability of the Conservatorship is suffering from a mental illness or mental disease.

2. That Colleen Chawla is the duly appointed Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo. By way of this Order, the Court hereby authorizes the individuals named in this Order to execute any document required for the sale or transfer of real property and/or personal property, including all stock and cash reserve transfers and redemption of bonds, and to receive cash value in return for a surrender of
